



## **Links Scholars in Medicine 2018**

The Links, Incorporated is an international, not-for-profit corporation established in 1946. The membership consists of nearly 15,000 professional women of color in 285 chapters in 41 states, the District of Columbia and the Commonwealth of the Bahamas. It is one of the nation's oldest and largest volunteer service organizations of extraordinary women who are committed to enriching, sustaining and ensuring the culture and economic survival of African Americans and other persons of African ancestry.

The Links established the Health and Human Services (HHS) facet in response to the chronic health disparities that persist in black communities and result in decreased life expectancy of African Americans and other people of African ancestry. The goal of HHS is to promote and facilitate programs that support the maintenance of good health and the elimination of chronic health disparities in communities of color through education, health advocacy, and health resources. The Links plays a significant role in providing crucial community education about health risks.

The Links recognizes that diversifying the physician workforce is one component that can improve the health of the African-American community. Knowing that the cost of a medical education is financially challenging, The Links will award five scholarships to medical students in the amount of \$25,000/year for two years (during their 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year of medical school matriculation).

### **Applicant Eligibility Requirements**

- Medical students who are approaching their third year of medical school
- Proof of U.S. citizenship
- Currently enrolled in an accredited U.S. medical school (and in good academic standing)
- Black/African-American female
- Demonstrated leadership ability
- Commitment to serving medically underserved communities

Applicants who are members of The Links, Incorporated or a daughter of a Link are not eligible.
