**FACE** DROOPING

Does one side of the face droop or is it numb?

**SPEECH**DIFFICULTY

Is speech slurred, is he or she unable to speak or hard to understand?

Ask the person to repeat a simple sentence. Is the sentence repeated correctly?

**ARM**WEAKNESS

Is one arm weak or numb?

Ask the person to raise both arms.

Does one arm drift downward?

TIME TO CALL 9-1-1

If the person shows any of these symptoms, even if the symptoms go away, call 9-1-1 and get him or her to the hospital immediately.
