Learn the Warning Signs of a Heart Attack

CHAT & HOST NOTES

Host Notes/Key Points:

- When "Broadcast" is started welcome everyone as they log in.
- Introduce yourself and the speaker.
- Remind everyone they are on mute until the Q&A portion of the session but drop questions into the chat box.
- Do not mention how many people are logged on - only the host and panelists see the number. Instead, say, *"Thank you to everyone who has joined us today! We have a great group and are excited to share this informative and empowering health lesson."*
- Direct individuals to visit www.heart.org for tools, resources and the latest information on how to stay healthy during this time.
- Email us at empoweredtoserve@heart.org for any specific questions.
- Remind participants to join another session later this week or next week. "There are a variety of dates and times to pick from, so invite others."
- When closing the session:
 - Thank everyone for joining.
 - Remind participants where to find information on the www.heart.org site.



Additional tips and tools:


- Monitor the chat box during the presentation.
